

EXTENDED NAAC MEETING ON NOVEMBER 21, 2022

A meeting of the extended NAAC was held on **November 21, 2022**, to present the compiled Annual Quality Assurance Report 2021-2022 and to report the initiatives by IQAC in 2021-2022.

Dr Aparna Jain welcomed the extended members Prof. Rakesh Seth (Alumni), Mr Manoj Yadav (Industrialist), Mr Manan Bawa (Student Representative), the Principal, and the other members of the IQAC CORE.

Chairman Governing Body (Member, Management) Mr Gaurav Sharma; Dr Sudhir Sehra, Nominee, Local Society; Prof. Debi Sarkar, Delhi University (Employer); and Mr Sunil Kumar Rattan, Parent Stakeholder expressed their inability to join the meeting.

Dr Jain noted the significant contributions by IQAC:

- Strengthening the mechanism for slow and advanced learners
- Introduction of audit for documentation of the staff council committees and societies
- Facilitating the collection of feedback and redressal of grievances
- Preparation for the implementation of NEP 2020
- Enhancing teaching learning environment

Dr Jain also shared the plan of action the IQAC shall work to accomplish in 2022-2023:

- To institute financial grants to teaching and non-teaching staff to facilitate participation in professional development programmes
- To organise professional development programmes
- To encourage the E-learning Cell and the Remedial Cell to organise skill-development programmes such as communication skills and ICT skills
- To support departments and societies to conduct capacity building programmes (soft skills, research skills, vocational skills, etc) for students
- To initiate and encourage programmes and collaborations among Departments of Humanities and Sciences to foreground and promote interdisciplinary/multidisciplinary relationship

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- To support the Research and Innovation Cell to promote interdisciplinary/multidisciplinary research projects (with topics) among students under the guidance of teachers
- To facilitate more measures for energy conservation on campus. Installing concrete steps such as installing motion-based lighting system in the premises.
- To strengthen alumni relations and to provide platforms to accomplished alumni to support the students

Dr Jain shared important information regarding included as part of the AQAR

- Students' strength and teachers' strength
- Mechanisms for environment sustainability
- Mechanisms for accessibility and assistive technologies for physically and visually handicapped students and faculty
- Two best practices of community outreach and promotion of inclusivity

Mr Manoj Yadav suggested industry-college interface and volunteered internship of students in his enterprise.
