#### Minutes of the Meeting:

#### Agenda No. 1 -

After detailed deliberations and discussions the committee members resolved the following action plan of IQAC for academic year 2024-25 considering the previous year experiences.

- (1) Streamlining the Multi-Disciplinary Courses according to NEP 2020 (UGCF-2022) of GE (Generic Elective), SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) and VAC (Value Added Course).
- (2) Promoting the Outreach, Collaborative academic activities and Internships in coordination with Universities and Industries.
- (3) Strengthen the College Alumni Activities for the welfare of the students including financial support.
- (4) Organizing the seminars, FDPs, Symposium and workshops for the students, faculty and non-teaching staff.
- (5) Synchronizing the internal academic audit in the tune of NIRF, NAAC and AISHE for academic progression.
- (6) To evolve the mechanism to trace the academic progression of pass out students and their significant achievements.
- (7) Streamlining the teaching learning process with add-on courses to achieve the academic excellence.
- (8) Promoting the Research Projects and Publications by involving the students for their research blending.

#### Agenda No. 2 -

The criterion core committee members and heads of all the 7 criterions identified the requirements on the basis of previous year limitations as follows:

#### 1. Criterion 1: CURRICULLAR ASPECTS

- i) Strengthening the feedback system of students, faculty, alumni and employers of industries with action taken report within stipulated time.
- ii) To integrate cross-cutting issues relevant to professional ethics, gender, human values, environment and sustainability in the academic curriculum.
- iii) To enhance the experiential learning project work, field work and internships.

#### 2. Criterion 2: TEACHING LEARNING AND EVALUATION

- i) To intensify the institutional assessment of learning level of students and organization of special programs for advance learners and slow learner students.
- ii) To assess the ICT enabled tools for effective teaching learning process in the college.
- iii) To streamline the student satisfaction survey (SSS) to measure the overall institutional performance based on the college designed questionnaire.

#### 3. Criterion 3: RESEARCH INNOVATIONS AND EXTENSION

- i) To take necessary steps to take the government and non governmental agencies funded research projects.
- ii) To increase the no. of faculty members as research guides for PhD.
- iii) To increase the no. of research paper per teacher in the SCOPUS journals.

- iv) To intensify the extension activities carried out in the neighborhood communities and sensitizing students to social issues as Swacch Bharat AIDS awareness and Gender sensitization for their holistic development and its impact by NSS and NCC units if the college.
- v) To take necessary to increase collaborative activities of research, faculty exchange, student exchange and internship through functional MoU's with industries, universities, NGO's and corporate houses.

# 4. Criterion 4: INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

- i) There is requirement to develop the gymnasium and yoga centre in the college.
- ii) Classrooms should be ICT and develop the LMS (Learning Management System) if possible.
- iii) A proper record of computers of the college be maintained and with location services enabled.
- iv) The footfall of faculty members in the library needs to be increased.

### 5. Criterion 5: STUDENT SUPPORRT AND PROGRESSION

- i) Student's capacity building and skill enhancement initiative required to be taken by the each department on soft skills, language and communication skills, life skills (health, hygiene, physical fitness and yoga etc.) and ICT/Computing skills.
- ii) Number of career counseling and competitive exams programs should be increased.
- iii) Mechanism to track the progression and placement of outgoing students in higher education and competitive exams of various levels to be recorded.
- iv) Record of the student awards and medals of students in sports and cultural activities.
- v) Number of students that participated in cultural and sports events in the college and outside the college needs to be recorded.
- vi) Alumni engagement for the welfare of students including financial support should be promoted.

# 6. Criterion 6: GOVERNANCE LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT

- i) Faculty empowerment strategy including financial support for conferences.
- ii) Professional development for teaching and non-teaching staff should be increased.
- iii) There should be proper recording of faculty members attending the professional development programmes (PDP's), orientation, induction, refresher, short term courses be recorded.
- iv) There should be review of teaching- learning process, structure, methodology of operations and learning outcomes by IQAC recording the incremental improvement in various activities
- v) IQAC collects the feedback, analyze and use it for improvement of collaborative quality initiatives with other institutions.
- vi) College may also procure ISO certification.

# 7. Criterion 7: INSTITUTIONAL VALUES AND BEST PRACTICE

- i) To intensify the majors that promotes gender equity.
- ii) College need to enhance the energy efficient equipment as LED and sensor based bulbs.
- iii) College has to develop the e-waste disposal management system.
- iv) Rain water harvesting pit in old building to be constructed.
