

Memorandum of Understanding Between



St. Joseph's College of Commerce (Autonomous), Bengaluru And Shivaji College (University of Delhi)

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made and entered between on the St. Joseph's College of Commerce (Autonomous), Bengaluru (SJCC) ONE PART and, on the Shivaji College (University of Delhi), Delhi (SC) OTHER PART (who for the purpose of this MoU are hereinafter individually referred to as "PARTY" and collectively referred to as the "PARTIES").

AND

St. Joseph's College of Commerce (Autonomous), Bengaluru (SJCC) Whereas is involved in education, research and training in Commerce, Management, Economics, and English.

Shivaji College (University of Delhi), Delhi (SC) AND Whereas is involve research, and training in Arts, Science, Commerce, Management, Humanities and Linguistics.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Article 1. Objectives

- 1.1 To associate in providing innovative courses, student and faculty exchange training and research programmes at SJCC and SC.
- 1.2 To collaborate in organizing seminars and workshops.
- 1.3 To collaborate in conducting outreach programmes in the community.
- 1.4 To promote joint publications of articles and collaborative projects for funding.
- 1.5 To improve the academic quality in mutual participation.

Article 2. Implementation

2.1. The parties agree to constitute an Implementation Committee comprising the following Participants.

- i) Principal, St. Joseph's College of Commerce (Autonomous), Bengaluru
- ii) Principal, Shivaji College (University of Delhi), Delhi (SC)

Article 3. General Provisions

- 3.1 Based on the requirements the implementation committee shall, in consultation with the faculty and professionals, decide on program / event and the mode of cooperation during the tenure of this Collaboration.
- 3.2 The institution organizing a work shall have the nodal responsibility for mobilizing resources and the conduct of such works.
- 3.3 Each party shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligation under this agreement. Neither party shall make a claim against the other party for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the parties at the time of planning of events.
- 3.4 Any dispute or difference arising between the parties shall be settled by mutual agreement. The disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to the respective higher officials for appropriate resolution.
- 3.5 Nothing in this understanding is intended to affect other cooperation or collaboration between the Parties.

Article 4. Tenure and Termination

- 4.1 This MoU shall come into effect from **November 27, 2024** by signatures of the authorized Parties and shall be **valid for three years**. It may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon one month's written notice to the other party.
- 4.2 All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of this understanding may be continued until their completion under the terms of this understanding.

Article 5. Amendments

- 5.1 This MoU represents the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes any and all understandings either oral or written hitherto with respect to the subject matter of this understanding.
- 5.2 No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of the MoU. The modifications/ changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are executed, unless otherwise agreed to.
