- It's important that each talk aligns with our [Content Guidelines](#), as there should be no political, pseudoscience, religious, or commercial Talks presented from the TEDx stage.
- Use your full TEDx name as it appears on your license, online and off. "TEDx" without your location name on stage is not allowed. If you can't get a stand-up, 3D logo, a [static projection screen also works!](#)
- Remember, there are [no exceptions to the 100 person rule](#).
- Completing the [TEDx Attendee Survey](#) is an expected part of the [Post-event requirements](#). Also, don't forget to upload your photos to [Flickr](#) too!
- You now have an official TEDx event page dedicated to this upcoming event! As the licensee, you are able to edit the event page with information about your event – theme description, speaker bios, event date, venue, etc. Learn about utilizing your event page to the fullest (and how to update it!) [here](#).
- Note that this license is valid for one year and for one event. Keep in mind that this TEDx license is granted to you, an individual, and not to the institution itself. This means that if you, or another student/staff member, wants to hold another event at the university, then a new application must be submitted from the unique TED account of the intended licensee.
