## Rules and Regulations:

1. The participants are required to speak on the topic- "Constitutional provisions: Citizens' rights v/s Citizens' duties for clean green environment".

- 2. Only individual participation is allowed.
- 3. The competition will consist of two rounds:

### **First: Preliminary Round**

- A. Each participant is required to write a summary of their arguments in about 150-200 words in either Hindi or English.
- B. The abstract should be submitted to <a href="mailto:ecowarriorsshivaji@gmail.com">ecowarriorsshivaji@gmail.com</a> latest by August 18, 2020 by 5 PM.
- C. The attachment should be a word document and the main text of the submission shall be in Font 'Times New Roman' 12 point for English and Font 'Mangal' 12 point for Hindi.
- D. Top 10 participants will move forward for round 2 as per the decision of the judges. They will be informed via email.

#### **Second: Online Debate**

- A. Final round will be held on AUGUST 20, 2020 ,11:00 AM onwards on ZOOM PLATFORM.
- B. All participants will be given 5 minutes to present their arguments and an additional 1 minute is allotted for interjection from the audience or the judges.

- A warning bell will be given to you at the end of 4:30 minutes and a final bell at the end of 5:00 minutes. You will have to stop your speech at the same time.
- C. All the participants will be allocated slots, in the same way, you will place your facts in front of everyone throughout the competition. Participants are expected to use their slot number in place of username before logging into Zoom Platform and identifying themselves.
- D. Only when someone is directed, they turn on their mic and video option, otherwise the others may face trouble.
- E. Participants may speak in Hindi or English, but must remain committed to one language.
- F. It would be completely inappropriate to use any kind of language that hurts anyone's feelings, then you should not do so.
- G. Participants will be evaluated on the basis of their content, delivery of speech and defense.
- H. The judgment of Judges will be final and binding.
