Guidelines for various Competitions

Rangoli Making Competition

- **Theme:** CHEMISTRY AND NATURE
- **Time:** 12:00 PM
- **Venue:** In front of Principal's office
- One team comprises two members only.
- A total of 45 minutes shall be given for preparing rangoli.
- Participants need to arrange the material for making rangoli.
- Registration is must to take part in this event.
- Judgment shall be based on relevance of the design to the theme, originality and creativity.
- The decision of the judges will be final.

Slogan Writing Competition

- **Time:** 1:00 PM
- **Venue:** Chemistry Lab 2
- Each participant can send only one entry.
- The theme will be shared on the spot.
- Participants can submit their entries either in Hindi or English.
- Participants are directed to mention their name, roll no., course with semester and name of the college & university, while submitting their entries.
- The participants must note that the slogan must reflect the core theme. Any inappropriate content would be liable for disqualification.
- The participants are requested to stick to the word limit of 25 words.
- Slogans must be original. Plagiarism would lead to disqualification.

- The participants would be judged on the basis of relevance to theme, originality and creativity.
- The decision of the judges will be final.

Ad-Mad

- **Time:** 2:00 PM
- **Venue:** Auditorium, Shivaji College
- A maximum of two participants are allowed in a team.
- The topic of the ad will be allotted through a lottery- based system by picking up the chit.
- The topic allotted will not be changed/ passed.
- Participant(s) can perform in either Hindi or English or Bilingual (Hindi + English).
- There will be two rounds for the competition.
- The ad should be original & must not be copied from anywhere.
- In Round- 1, participant(s) will be given 3 minutes. Two minutes for discussion/ thinking about the ad & one minute for performing the ad.
- In Round- 2, participant(s) will be given 2 minutes. One minute for discussion/ thinking about the ad & one minute for performing the ad.
- Participant(s) are advised to adhere to the decorum & should not use abusive language. Further, their act should not harm anybody's sentiments, religion, caste, region, nation's pride etc.
- Participant(s) will be judged on the basis of the content, theme, punchline used, creativity etc.
- In case of any tie between different teams, the teams will be given 1 + 1+ 1 chances for tiebreaking.
- The decision of the judges will be final.

Chemical Charades

- **Time:** 12:00 PM (for preliminary round), 3:00 PM (For first and final rounds)
- **Venue:** Chemistry Lab 1 (for preliminary round), Auditorium, Shivaji College (For first and final rounds)
- The topic of the Chemical charades will be allotted through a lottery-based system by picking up the chit.
- The topic allotted will not be changed/ passed.
- There will be three rounds for the competition. Participants will be given 30 seconds for the preliminary round, 45 seconds for first round and 1 minute for final round.
- Each team should have only 2 members (one will present and other will guess the word)
- Participant(s) are advised to adhere to the decorum & their presentation should not harm anybody's sentiments, religion, caste, region, nation's pride etc.

- The team may be disqualified, if found to use unfair means like lip sync/ making sounds.
- In case of any tie between different teams, the teams will be given 1 + 1+ 1 chances for tiebreaking.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
