### C. Detailed Syllabus: Paper - I

- (i) General Awarness: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's General Awareness of the environment and its relevance to the society. The questions will also be designed to test knowledge of the current events and of such matters of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The test will include questions relating to India and her neighboring countries, especially pertaining to History, Indian Polity & Constitution, Art & Culture, Geography, Economics, General Policy, Science & Scientific Research, National/International Organizations /Institutions, events etc.
- (ii) Reasoning Ability: The syllabus includes questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. Test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship, concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc.
- (iii) Mathematical Ability: The test will cover Number System including questions on Simplification. Decimals, Fractions, L.C.M., H.C.F., Ratio & Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit & Loss, Discount, Simple & Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Tables & Graphs, etc.
- (iv) Test of Language English or Test of Language Hindi: In addition to the testing of candidate's understanding of the English or Hindi Languages, its Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc. would also be tested.

#### Detailed Syllabus: Paper - II

Essay, comprehension & letter writing: This test is meant for testing the applicability and correct usage of the language, where the candidates would be assessed through essay writing, comprehension and letter writing, situation test analysis etc.

#### Skill Test:

The typing test shall be a skill test, which shall be qualifying in nature and no additional credits for the same shall be allocated.

#### Note:

- 1. The question paper should be bilingual (English and Hindi) and the applicant will have the option to respond in either of the language. However, the same medium of language must be used throughout.
- 2. The questions in the written test will be of the level of degree/diploma/examination which is defined as the minimum eligibility for the respective post.
- 3. The minimum qualifying marks for Paper I and Paper II separately shall be 45% for the unreserved posts and 40% for the posts reserved for OBC category and 35% for the posts reserved for SC/ST/ PwBD category. If the number of candidates qualifying is more than 30 times the advertised posts, the merit list would be restricted to 30 times the advertised posts for the purpose of shortlisting the candidates for skill test.
- 4. Answer script of Paper-II of a candidate would be evaluated only if the candidate qualifies in Paper-I.
- 5. There shall be negative marking for wrong answers in Paper I to the tune of 1/4th of marks allocated per question.
- 6. Merit list shall be drawn only for candidates who qualify Paper I, Paper II and skill test, separately. The Merit list shall be drawn on the basis of combined scores of Paper I and Paper II only.
- 7. In case of bunching/bracketing of candidates in the results of the written test, the priority/merit list would be decided as follows:
  - a) The candidate having more marks in aggregate in the examination/degree/diploma which is defined as the minimum eligibility for the respective post will be given preference.
  - b) In case of further bunching/bracketing of candidates, candidate senior in age will be given preference.
  - c) In case option at (a) and (b) is exhausted, it will be decided through draw of lots.

## POINTS TO BE REMEMBERED (IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS)

- 1. In case of any discrepancy/query regarding this notification, candidate may contact the College office w.e.f. the date of this notification to the date preceding the date of exambetween office working hours i.e. from 09:00 A.M. to 05:30 P.M.
- 2. Every candidate as per list enclosed is hereby advised to note down his/her Roll No./ and required to bring his/her Photo ID Proof at the time of Written Exam.
- 3. Candidates shall be present at the Examination Centre 45 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- 4. No candidate shall be admitted to the Examination Room/Hall after the commencement of the examination i.e. after 10:00 a.m.
- 5. No candidate shall be allowed to leave the Examination Room/Hall before the conclusion of the test and without handing over the Answer Sheet and Test Booklet to the Invigilator concerned. Failure to do so would result in cancellation of candidature.
- 6. The candidates shall not remove any page(s) from the Test Booklet and if any page(s) is/are found missing from his/her Test Booklet, he/she will be proceeded against and shall be liable for criminal action.
- 7. Calculators, Log tables, Calculating devices, Mobile Phones. Pagers & Other Communication Devices, Side Rules, Geometry Box and Textual material etc. are not allowed inside the premises where examination is being conducted. The examination centre shall not make any arrangement to keep the mobile phones in safe custody.
- 8. The candidate must ensure that he/she fulfills all the eligibility conditions. If at any time, it is observed that he/she is not meeting the minimum eligibility conditions, his/her candidature shall be summarily rejected.
- 9. Any infringement of instructions shall entail disciplinary action including ban from future examinations.
