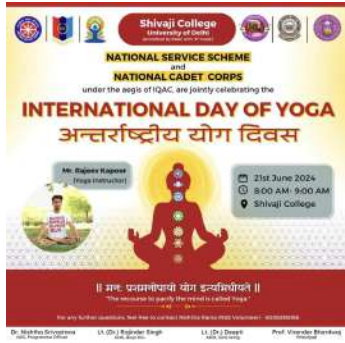

International Day of Yoga 2023 - 21.06.2024

Human Chain Formation on “SIGNIFICANCE OF NUTRITION ON HUMAN HEALTH” - 03.10.24

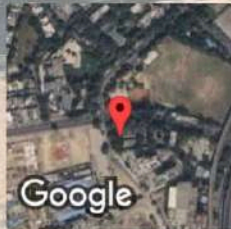

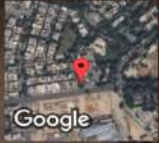

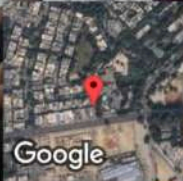
